

Department of Biomedical Engineering Direct Admission to Doctoral Program Guidelines for Students

Approved by the Department Meeting on Aug. 19, 2015

Approved by the Department Meeting on Feb. 16, 2022

1. This guideline is established based on the "Chung Yuan Christian University Student Direct Admission to Doctoral Program Regulations."
2. Eligibility and Criteria for Recognition:
 - (1) Bachelor's degree students who are about to graduate: Must have excellent academic performance during their studies and demonstrate research potential. (Criteria: Ranked in the top 30% of the department in previous years.)
 - (2) Master's degree students: Must have excellent academic performance during their studies and demonstrate research potential. (Criteria: An average score of 80 or above in the department in previous years.)
3. Quota: Limited to 40% of the doctoral program enrollment quota approved by the Ministry of Education for the academic year.
4. Application Period: As announced by the department.
5. Course Requirements (excluding 12 credits for the doctoral thesis):
 - (1) For Bachelor's degree students directly admitted to the doctoral program, a minimum of 36 credits must be completed (excluding seminars and discussions).
 - (2) For Master's degree students directly admitted to the doctoral program, a minimum of 36 credits must be completed, including credits earned during the master's program (excluding seminars and discussions, with a maximum of 18 credits eligible for transfer).
6. Any matters not covered here will be governed by the "Chung Yuan Christian University Student Direct Admission to Doctoral Program Regulations" and the department's academic regulations or related provisions.
7. These guidelines will be implemented upon approval by the departmental meeting, and the same applies to any amendments.
